Corporate Kids Events Staff-to-Child Ratios for Neurotypical Children-

Infants 0 years to 2 years 1:2

Children 3 years to 5 years 1:4

Children 6 years to 12 years 1:6

Children 13 years to 17 years 1:8

Attendees of any age with special needs to be staffed at a ratio of 1:2

- **Diapering** is provided up to age 4; at 4+, a parent/guardian will be notified by phone/text if diapering is needed
- **Toileting:** Caregivers will accompany any age with walking to/from and inside both gender restrooms, not just to the door, will assist with dressing, washing hands, etc
- **Age range?** Any age attendee with special needs is welcome, as are neurotypical siblings age infant to 17
- They have \$5,000,000 in liability **insurance** coverage
- **What if my child has seizures?** Onsite caregivers are not Seizure Safety Certified, however a Dup15q volunteer will provide a brief training before the start of each day's program, and we have provided the caregivers with informational videos from the National Epilepsy Foundation.
- **Are they CPR Certified?** The onsite manager and at least one staff member in each room will be CPR certified, and all caregivers are trained in basic first aid and choking procedure. All CKE staff are required to provide copies of all certifications, clearances, and detailed resumes, and CKE performs extensive reference checks and security background checks on each potential staff member.
- **What is their experience?** Staff is local to Nashville, and the CKE recruitment process will include looking for college students, teachers, etc that have experience specifically working with special needs children. CKE has worked with CHARGE Syndrome Foundation, National Hemophilia Foundation, Children's Hospital Los Angeles Oncology, and other organizations that work with special needs kids.
- **What will my child be doing?** Staff will set up 2 rooms for attendees, an active room and a "quiet room," to accommodate various needs. There will be a minimum of 50 sq. feet per child attending. Caregivers provide coloring, sand play, crafts, toys, games, dancing, and day camp type of activities modified toward ability level. Dup15q Alliance will also provide some adaptive toys for use in the rooms during staffed care.
- **Can we bring a snack for my child?** Snacks are fine but caregivers cannot do a tube feeding. They ask for non nut items if possible. All caregivers are trained in basic choking procedures.
